

## Application for JD Hobden Scholarship Fund

The Dr. J.D. Hobden Awards shall provide financial support in the form of a scholarship or bursary, to individuals for the advancement of education.

**Award Criteria:** Applicants must have been subjected to and dealt with by the criminal justice system in any province of Canada, and demonstrate the ability, need, and worthiness to qualify for or to gain learning and experience in a trade or other profession, at any educational institution in British Columbia.

**Funder:** The Dr. J.D. Hobden Scholarship Fund, a permanent endowment fund held at Vancouver Foundation. Annual funding will vary year to year, depending upon Vancouver Foundation's distribution rate.

The number of scholarships awarded in any one year will depend on the Fund's balance and its governing laws.
